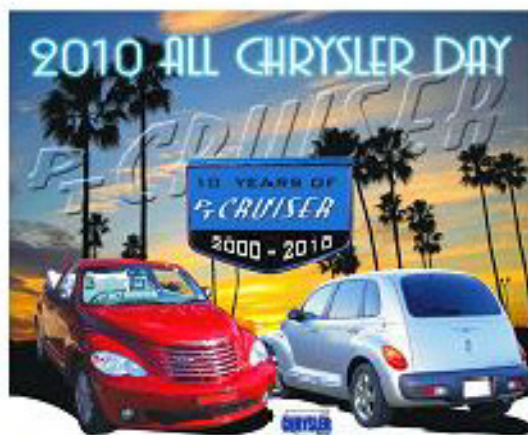
### Bundanoon and Fitzroy Falls July 10th
