October Weekend in Batemans Bay

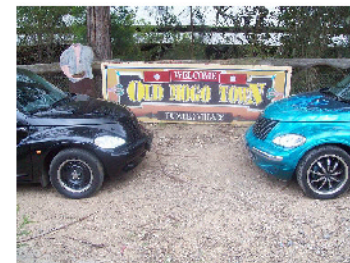
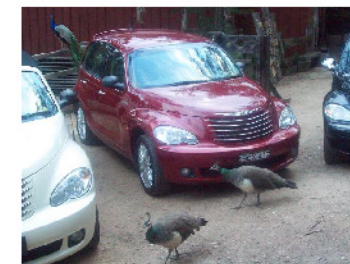
October saw a group of members travel to Batemans Bay for several days. 5 PT's
